Spring has arrived and tee times at Farm d'Allie are filling up. Pace of play is important when there is a full course. Here are four helpful tips to keep play moving at a steady pace. This applies to non-tournament play.

1. Play ready golf regardless of who is furthest away. This applies to the tee box as well.
2. Don't wait in the cart for your partner to play. Get dropped off and move the cart to the next player's location.
3. Adhere to the time limit for looking for a ball. Play lost balls as a lateral hazard.
4. Move to the next tee box to fill out score cards, clean golf balls or to wipe off dirty clubs. On the 18<sup>th</sup> hole, move away from the green to complete all tasks.
